### **6. i. RESEARCH ENDEAVOURS**

I work on the documentation, revitalization, and acquisition of Mayan languages. I am currently working on the **revitalization of Itzaj**, an endangered language of Guatemala. In this project, I have developed a pedagogical grammar of Itzaj and implemented the Oxlajuj Aj teaching method. I have **documented** narratives in Chuj from San Mateo Ixtatán, San Sebastián Cootán, and Nentón, and narratives in K'iche' and Awakateko from Aguacatán. I have documented the **acquisition** of Mayan languages, e.g. Q'anjob'al, Chuj. I am currently working on two topics: acquisition of ideophones in Chuj and how L2 learners use the sound system of Itzaj.

### i. Pedagogical grammars for language revitalization

The **Itzaj pedagogical grammar**, published by the Guatemalan Ministry of Education, will be presented in San José-Petén on April 26, 2024. In May 2024, the Itzaj instructors will start teaching Itzaj to elementary school teachers of San José using this grammar.

I am extending this model of grammar to two Mayan languages: **Q'anjob'al** and **Huastec**. For Q'anjob'al, I am working with two native speakers of Q'anjob'al. For Huastec, I am working with Nadia Takhtaganova, Itzel Oskarova (my former student from Universidad Autónoma de Querétaro, Mexico), Professor Lucero Meléndez Guadarrama (Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México) and with a group of native speakers of Huastec.

**Undergraduate** and **graduate** students have been engaged in the **linguistic research** of the revitalization of Itzaj. Daniela and Nathalia (undergraduate students) have transcribed audio files of L2 learners of Itzaj. Laura Griffin (graduate student) is working on the digital version of the Itzaj grammar and plan to do research on the phonetics of L2 learners of Itzaj.
